#### [Rivergate Marina & Shipyard – Brisbane](#)

- 105 berths
- Deep water access and 12 berths for superyachts over 100 feet
- Extensive facilities including a service berth for yachts up to 230 feet, refit complex and an air-conditioned crew lounge and kitchen
- Minutes away from Brisbane Central Business District, domestic and international airport terminals.
